

# INSTRUCTIONS FOR „(ART)WORK, CITY, SPACE“

„(Art)Work, City, Space“ is played the same way as the classic game „City, Country, River“, just with terms related to the theatre!

IT WORKS LIKE THIS:



## 1. SELECT A LETTER OF THE ALPHABET

You choose a letter, for instance by one player saying „A“ out loud and then continuing to list the alphabet in their head. Another player says „stop“ and you have a letter.

## 2. RULES

Let's go – every player fills out each category with an appropriate word, which begins with the chosen letter. It doesn't matter which order you fill them out in.



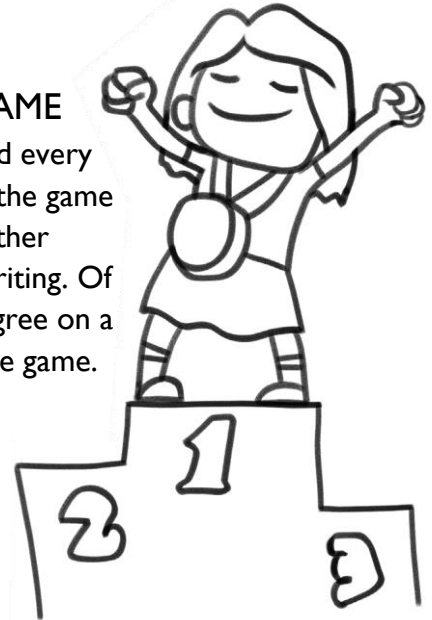
## 3. EXPLANATION OF CATEGORIES

- **Name of (art)work** – the title of a play, opera, operetta, or piece of music, e.g. Woyzeck, Vier linke Hännchen, Peter and the Wolf
- **City with a theatre** – find a city or town in which there is a theatre, opera house or similar e.g. Parchim, Schwerin, Hamburg
- **Spaces/rooms within a theatre** – e.g. foyer, dress circle, rehearsal room
- **Musical instrument** – i.e. clarinet, bassoon, harp
- **Prop** – props are all the objects onstage which are not nailed down (apart from set pieces and costumes), e.g. rubbish bin, hinge, bell

- **Job in the theatre** – all professions which you find in a theatre (or similar organisation) are allowed, e.g. decorator, stage hand, dancer
- **Role in a play** – every name or label, which appears as a role in a production, is allowed e.g. Frida, Mephisto, Rico Doretto

## 4. END OF THE GAME

When a player has filled every category with a word, the game is over – then all the other players have to stop writing. Of course, you could all agree on a different way to end the game.



## 5. HOW TO ALLOCATE POINTS

- No word in a category – 0 points
- A word that someone else also wrote in the same category – 5 points
- A word that nobody else wrote in the same category – 10 points
- The only person to have a word in a specific category – 20 points

The winner is the person with the most points.
